From there we stayed at a location outside Antibe where we could easily visit Nice, the Matisse Museum, Renoir's home and studio, the Chagall Museum, Picasso Museum and Maeght Museum. Another highlight was our visit to the Ville Ephrussi, the mansion and gardens of the Baroness Rothschild. Of course a visit to this area would not be complete without time to explore St. Paul de Vence! This magical walled village is a favorite of mine. Getting a chance to eat lunch at the Column d'Or and to see all the fabulous artwork that famous artists traded art for meals was amazing! All in all, the trip was great and the artists/travelers even better!

It was fortunate to be invited to exhibit my work at such wonderful venues. At the Plymouth Art Foundation in Plymouth, WI., I exhibited with Pat Reiher and Marilyn Smith in February. In July, I opened a one woman show at the Pagosa Springs Arts Council in Pagosa Springs, CO. November brought 2 shows; a one woman show at Originals in Waupaca, WI., and "In the Flesh" an invitational group show at The Center for the Visual Arts in Wausau, WI. 


Note Cards



Italian Artistic Adventure

Join Dave and me for this unique Italian Artistic Adventure in the heart of Italy! La Romita is a restored 16th century Capuchin monastery above the ancient Roman city of Terni, just an hour away from Rome. The art school has invited me to bring a group to paint and explore the surrounding countryside for two full weeks. I CAN ONLY BRING 18 TRAVELERS, PLEASE SIGN UP AS SOON AS POSSIBLE! I hope you will consider joining this Italian Artistic Adventure.

La Romita is located in the region of Umbria, often described as the "The Green Heart of Italy"," Green Umbria" and the "Land of the Saints and Worriers". The three and a half acre gated complex is located in an ancient olive grove surrounded by a stone wall clinging to the hillsides in level coursing. The rooms feature sweeping vistas of Monte Torre Maggiore and the surrounding foothills of the Apennine mountains above the bustling city of Terni. The chapel, featuring frescoed walls and religious oil paintings, was built in 1548 and is used today as the painting studio and study center.

We plan to do 6 HALF-DAY TRIPS to small villages and then return to the monastery to paint in the chapel studio or relax on the patio. These little villages are quiet, with narrow, winding streets, stairways and arches. Many of these towns perch on volcanic bluffs of the tops of hills and seem to spill down the sides of dramatic landscapes. We will also enjoy 6 FULL DAY TRIPS to larger cities to see churches, Renaissance gardens and museums. Shopping in Umbria is a singularly rewarding experience as well. The region is

known for its artisans, hand painted pottery, weaving, textiles and leather good at surprisingly affordable prices. The wines, olive oil, truffles...... delicacies too numerous to list, make Umbria a favorite destination for Italians, but still virtually undiscovered by foreigners.

La Romita will provide our daily transportation and serve us delicious HOME COOKED MEALS on the enclosed porch. The ancestors of the Quargnali family bought the monastery from the church 150 years ago and has successfully run the La Romita School of Art for nearly 40 years. La Romita is a home away from home, comfortable and nurturing. You will explore and paint a part of Italy few tourists ever experience.

This program will be conducted differently from my past tours. The cost for La Romita DOESN,T include the airfare to Rome. YOU WILL HAVE TO SECURE YOUR OWN FLIGHTS! I have found a perfect non-stop flight with American Airlines. You can call Ruth at Ambassador Travel in Oshkosh to purchase your tickets. 920-236-7777 or toll free at 1-877-323-7757. It is important that we ALL arrive at the Rome Airport (by 11:00) at the same time to be picked up by La Romita. If you miss this ride, it will cost you \$150 or more for a taxi ride to our location! IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU GET YOUR FLIGHTS ASAP!

THE COST OF THE TRIP IS \$2750 not including your flight.
